The At-Risk (31A) paraprofessionals will assist the teaching staff in carrying out duties to provide additional academic services to At-Risk (31A) identified struggling students. The paraprofessional will work 18 hours per week when students are in session. This position is grant funded until June, 2018.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities

- Work with small groups of students to reinforce learning in academic areas (math, English (reading and writing), or science)
- Progress monitor students in intervention groups
- Meet with counselors, teachers, coaches, interventionists to discuss student needs
- Keep daily activity logs that include the subject, objective, time, and student
- Keep the principal and counselor apprised of the progress of At-Risk (31A) students
- Participate in At-Risk (31A) family/parent activities

Education and experience

Para professionals will have an Associate's (or higher) Degree, or pass the Work Keys assessment in accordance with No Child Left Behind.

Paraprofessionals will have the capacity to work with students in grades 5th through 12th grade in math, English (reading and writing), or science.
