COVID-19 Updates for the 2020-2021 School Year

As we prepare to return to the 2020-2021 school year, we face uncertainty with the Covid-19 pandemic, and what that will mean for our students.

The Governor of Michigan has released the Return to School Roadmap, and has asked each school district to create a learning plan that will correlate with each phase of the reopening of the state. Quincy Community Schools has created a school opening committee to help organize these plans. This committee has representation from the school board, parents, teachers, food service, custodial/maintenance, transportation, technology, school administration, and the association. With input from this committee, it is our hope that we will establish

a unified plan for each phase that will support our students, staff, and parents in a positive and productive way as we move through some unprecedented times.

Currently, our first day of school for the 2020-2021 school year is scheduled to be Monday, August 24, 2020. We are hopeful that our buildings will be open for students to return in a face-to-face format, and are also working on a virtual format for those who need a little more time before returning. We look forward to working with all of you as we develop this program for the upcoming school year. Please stay tuned for further updates on this plan as we enter August. Quincy Community Schools Annual Pesticide Notification

Within 30 days of the beginning of each school year, Quincy Community Schools is required to provide written notification to parents/guardians of children attending the school of their right to be informed before any pesticide applications are made to their children's school. From time to time, it is necessary for the district to apply pesticides for the health and well-being of people at the school but pesticides are only used when necessary. Advance notice of pesticide applications will be given at

least 48 hours prior to the application by posting at the main entrances of the school facility and at the central office location as well. In an emergency, a pesticide application may occur without prior notice but notice will be provided following any application.

Upon request, parents or guardians are entitled to written notice prior to pesticide application. To receive prior written notification for pesticide applications, please complete the pesticide notification

form, which is available in all of the school offices. If the form is not returned, Quincy Community Schools will assume that prior notification is not requested.

At any time should you have questions or concerns about pest management within your children's school, please contact the Maintenance and Custodial Supervisor at BowmanJ@Quincyschools.org.
